



# LTV to Host Community Housing Fund Forum

LTV Studios will host a Community Housing Fund Forum on Friday, October 7, from 6 to 8 p.m. The proposed New York State transfer tax will be up for a vote by citizens in the upcoming election in November. LTV's Matthew Lownes will be moderating the discussion.

Panelists will include East Hampton Town Supervisor Peter Van Scoyoc, Southampton Town Supervisor Jay Schneiderman, Assemblyman Fred Thiele, Legislator Bridget Fleming, and State Senator Anthony Palumbo. Additional expertise will be provided by East Hampton Housing Authority Executive Director Catherine Casey.

While questions will be prepared for the panelists, the goal of this forum is for the public to be a focal point of the discussion. Questions may be asked by community members about the fund or affordable housing in general.

“We have all felt the impact of the post-COVID housing boom in our community, and LTV wants to provide the opportunity for citizens to be prepared and informed prior to the November Election,” said Lownes in a press release announcing the event.
